Cabot Shores Golf Packages



#1. Double the fun package - Three nights, 18 holes on 2 courses (Highland links, Bell Bay). Includes a room at Cabot Shores 4-star resort for 3 nights, 2 days, two free breakfasts to get you on your way to a wonderful golf day and of course your green fees. Shuttle service is available (\$20/head for both locations), golf cart not included.

Price - \$425 per person, based on double occupancy.

#2. Par 3 Package - Four nights, 18 holes on 3 courses (Bell Bay, Highland Links, Dundee). Includes a room at Cabot Shores 4-star resort for 4 nights, 3 days, three free breakfasts, free shuttle to the Dundee course, golf cart not included.

Price - \$655 per person, based on double occupancy.

#3. Ultimate Chalet Golf Package (72 holes of golf). A minimum group of 4 people required.



Five nights, 18 holes on 2 courses (Bell Bay & Dundee) and 36 holes on the world famous Highland Links. - **Highland Links** - The Highlands Links is a special place where nature has been sculpted into a one-of-a-kind golf course. Under the watchful eye and delicate hand of renowned golf course designer, Stanley Thompson, the majesty of Cape Breton's Highlands has embraced every golfer who has come to take up the challenge laid down by the master over 60 years ago. With each stroke, they travel back to 1939, when Thompson designed his "mountains and ocean" course.

This inspired 18-hole, par 72 course is set within one of Canada's most beautiful natural settings- the Cape Breton Highlands National Park of Canada. Together, Thompson's genius, the contributions of the local community and the dedicated efforts of Parks Canada have resulted in the restoration of a legendary course which delivers a unique experience to all golfers, no matter what level of expertise they bring with them.

- **Bell Bay** - Bell Bay Golf Club is situated in the scenic village of Baddeck, Cape Breton Island. This beautiful Thomas McBroom course sits high above the Bras d'Or Lakes, North America's beautiful inland sea, overlooking the Bay from which it derives its name. The course offers incredible views from virtually every hole. Four distinct teeing areas on each hole have been provided to ensure challenging and enjoyable golf for players of all skill levels. Our bent grass tees, greens and fairways have been nurtured by Bell Bay's turf-care specialists, making golf at Bell Bay a pleasurable experience.

Baddeck is a saltwater port, and ships have been built here, and sailed from here, since earliest times. Many of them were known in harbors around the world, their names reflecting their Cape Breton origins. It seems fitting that this seaside golf course should recall some of those famous ships by giving their names to appropriate holes, whose character is reflected in their names.



- **Dundee Golf Course** - Dundee Golf Club on Cape Breton Island, Nova Scotia offers magnificent golf and spectacular views. This Robert Moote-designed course nestled on the side of South Mountain offers spectacular vistas of the Bras d'Or Lakes from virtually every hole. This championship course is one that demands excellent control and shot placement.
